The complex is constantly upgraded; court surfaces are in good condition and LED lighting is at competition standard throughout most of the centre. We are seeking an outstanding individual to work with CBTA and continue on with the excellent work of building up the centre.

Interested persons and organisations are required to prepare written submissions responding to the following key criteria:

- 1) Ability to meet financial requirements and capacity to provide financial guarantee (bond)
- 2) Proven work ethic
- 3) Demonstrated management expertise in running of a tennis complex.
- 4) Proven coaching qualification, experience and expertise in dealing with clients
- 5) Ability to generate potential players to participate in the Association's internal competitions, Interdistrict competition and Tournament events.
- 6) Proven capacity to relate on a day to day basis with voluntary officials of the Association.
- 7) Ability to operate the centre 7 days/evenings to meet Association/client expectations
- 8) Vision for the future development of the Panania Centre into a regional tennis centre.
- 9) Ability to meet deadlines including preparing written weekly reports for the Association.
- 10) Work with the CBTA to promote competitions under a variety of formats
- 11) References/Referees to support the candidate's claims, along with a detailed CV.
